Please join us for a walking tour of a selection of Sears homes in our community

From 1908 to 1940 Sears, Roebuck, & Co. sold kit homes by catalog. Buyers could choose from many styles, which could also be customized. These houses were a more economical option than custom-built homes. Once buyers had arranged the financing, lumber began arriving by rail, each piece precut and labeled for easy construction. The company hoped that buyers would then go on to outfit their homes with fixtures, appliances, and furniture from the Sears catalog. Mt. Healthy boasts several Sears homes.

Tickets are \$20 per person and must be paid for ahead of time through PayPal or by check (please allow at least one week for delivery).

Tours will begin at 10 and 10:30 a.m. at the Mt. Healthy Historical Society Museum, 1544 McMakin Ave. Doors open at 9:30. Please arrive 20 minutes before your tour is scheduled to begin. Restrooms are available in the museum.

Please note that this is a walking tour lasting approximately 1.5 hours. Sidewalks and curbs may be uneven and the tour may include a slight grade. The tour is not handicap accessible.
