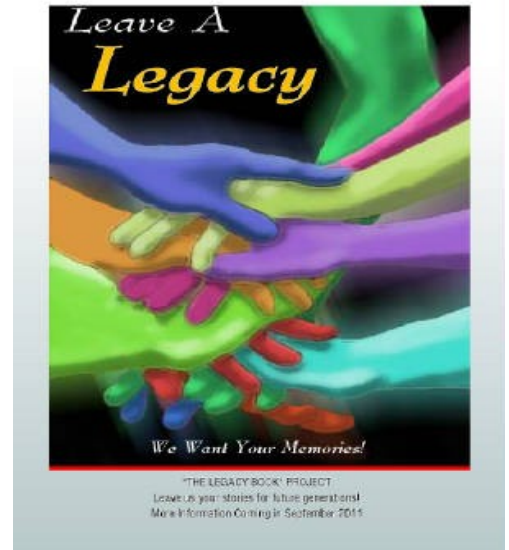
## Ice Cream Social–September 10, 2011

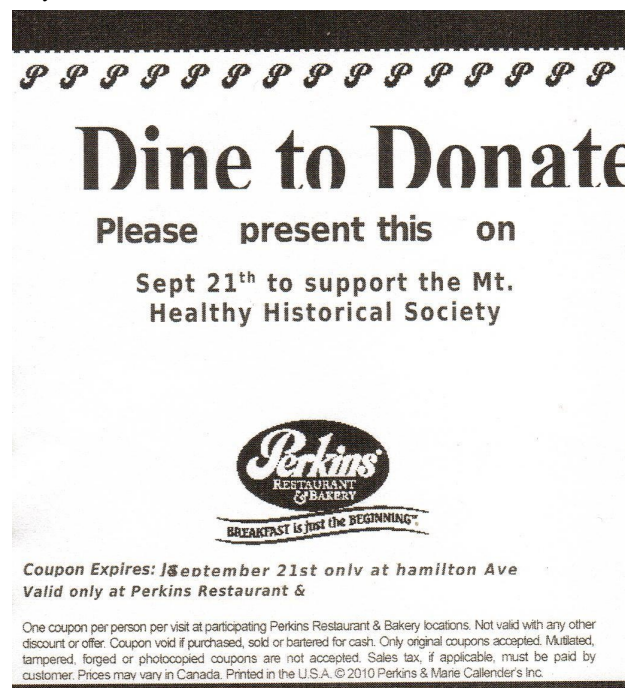
## Leave a Legacy!
